### DESCRIPTION

His defense lawyer refers to him as an animal, a *hog*, too dumb to know how to keep himself out of trouble. This young black man, Jefferson, is an unwitting party to a liquor store shootout in which three men are killed; he is convicted of murder and sentenced to death. Grant Wiggins, a university educated grade school teacher, is recruited by Jefferson's grandmother to teach Jefferson a "lesson before dying"; she wants her grandson to die a man, not a *hog*.
